

Camille Levy Biography

Camille Levy is GE Steam Power's APAC (Asia Pacific and China) Regional leader – in this role she drives growth and profitability for Steam Power in the region. Her team is the face of Steam Power to our customer in this region and are responsible for delivering the best technological solutions on time and on budget. Steam Power has an installed base of nearly 140GW of steam turbines, 90 GW of generators, 70 GW of boilers and 200 GW of air quality controls systems in the APAC region. Steam Power is currently executing large-scale power projects in China, Malaysia and Thailand.



Camille has been with GE, and previously Alstom, for more than 10 years and has held leadership roles of increasing responsibility. In 2018, Camille led tendering for Clean Combustion, which includes the latest GE's technology for boilers and emissions control systems for coal-fired power plants.

Camille is passionate about the energy industry -power generation and transmission, clean and low carbon technologies. She started her career as an energy economist with CERA, a US-based consulting firm where she advised governments, utilities and energy companies in Europe and the Middle-East on regulatory issues and market entry strategies. She joined Alstom's Corporate Strategy team in 2007, where she drove growth and diversification initiatives at the company level. She then held several roles in finance and tendering and was the integration leader for Alstom's Grid business. From 2011 to 2015, she was a Sales Director for France where she was responsible for servicing critical equipment for France's 58 nuclear plants. When GE acquired Alstom's power and grid businesses in November 2015, she joined GE Steam Power.

Camille graduated from HEC School of Management with a MSC in Management and from Paris Dauphine with an MSc in industrial economics. She is based in Singapore.
